Colonel Christopher M. Sheffield is Vice Commander, Space Launch Delta 30, Vandenberg Space Force Base, California. His portfolio includes all base services, housing, personnel, logistics, emergency services, transportation, morale and recreation services, civil engineering, contracting, and security. In this role, he supports more than 1,500 personnel operating the third largest installation in the Department of the Air Force with over 99,000 acres, 4,100 quarters and buildings committed to 26 Space Launch Delta organizations, and 45 contractors employing over 10,000 people.

Colonel Sheffield received his commission through the United States Air Force Academy in June 1999. He has served in a variety of positions within the Security Forces career field, including experience in Nuclear Security, Antiterrorism, Operational Planning, and Technical Training. He is a three time Squadron Commander and a former Deputy Group Commander. His deployment experience includes deployments in support of Operations IRAQI and ENDURING FREEDOM. Prior to his current assignment, Colonel Sheffield served as Chief, Integrated Defense Policy Division, Directorate of Security Forces, Headquarters Air Force, Pentagon, Washington D.C.
