SUBJECT: Space Launch Delta 30 Environmental Commitment Statement

- c. Use the expertise of the Environment, Safety, and Occupational Health Council and Environmental Management System (EMS) Cross-Functional Team (CFT) to identify key environmental aspects, establish objectives and targets, and then review and track progress.

Commanders must ensure their members are trained in EMS, know their respective roles and responsibilities and support their Unit Environmental Coordinators in executing those responsibilities.
